# Wisconsin's Best Rib Fest Local Rib Cook-Off Monday, Sept 4, 2017 Menominee Park, Oshkosh, WI 54901



#### REQUIREMENTS

- -All teams participating in Wisconsin's Best Rib Fest Local Rib Cook-Off must have pre-registered and paid the \$30.00 entry fee for the first rack entry and \$20.00 for any additional rack entries. This is a non-refundable entry fee.
- -All entries must be prepared and cooked at Menominee Park in the designated cooking area. You may season or prepare the meat as you see fit **AFTER** the meat inspection by the health department.
- -Cooking can be done on a charcoal, wood fire, wood pellet or propane cooker of any design.
- -No alcohol of any kind may be brought into the festival grounds. Coolers will be inspected.
- -Limited spots are available on a first come, first serve basis. Sign up early.
- -This cook-off competition is open to any/all barbeque enthusiasts.

# Please Note: You are responsible for observing prudent temperature and sanitary requirements as set by the Winnebago County Health Department.

#### **RULES**

- 1. Each team will consist of a chief cook and up to 1 assistant (wristbands are assigned and required). Any extra family members will have to go thru the main gate.
- 2. Each team will provide a grill/cooker to be used exclusively by that team within the confines of the team's assigned cooking space.
- 3. Each team will provide their own tent which will be a 10' x 10" max, such as an easy up style.
- 4. All cooking areas must be covered.
- 5. Each team will bring their own products, including meat, seasonings, cords and all cooking equipment needed. Please keep in mind, no home canned goods are allowed per the health department.
- 6. No vehicles are allowed in or by the cooking area. There will be designated parking for contestants outside the cooking area.
- 7. Contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire, health and other codes whether local, state or federal.
- 8. No Cooking of any kind may begin before meat inspection and approval.
- 9. All contestants are expected to respect the rights of other teams. This is a family event. Profane language or infringement on another team's area will not be permitted.

#### **TIMELINE**

11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Open to the public

7:00 a.m. Set up

7:30 a.m. Meat inspection

2:00 p.m. Judging

3:00 p.m. Awards presented

#### **SET UP**

- 1. Each team will be assigned a space.
- 2. Set-up is at Menominee Park
- 3. There will be an area for car, truck or trailer parking outside the festival/cooking area.
- 4. Generators are not allowed.

### **Judging Overview**

- 1. Teams must cook at least one (1) full rack of ribs (baby back or spare ribs).
- 2. Each team must prepare five (5) individual pieces of meat servings for the judges.
- 3. Anything placed in the container that identifies your team will disqualify your entry. Each team will be identified by number.
- 4. All samples must be delivered to the judging area at 2:00 p.m. and will be marked.

# **Judging Criteria**

- 1. Entries will be judged by a judging team of 5 judges (1 celebrity and 4 "ribbers").
- 2. Each entry will be judged on Taste, Tenderness and Appearance.

The scoring system is 10 (excellent) to 1 and all in whole numbers.

In case of a tie, it will be broken as follows. The scores will be compared for the highest cumulative scores in Taste, Tenderness and Appearance. The lowest score will be dropped and the higher cumulative scores will break the tie. If still tied, the process will be repeated, dropping the second lowest score and the higher cumulative scores will break the tie and determine a Champion!

- 3. No garnish or sauce containers will be allowed in the turn-in box.
- 4. Product may be presented with or without sauce or seasonings.
- 5. If you choose to use a sauce with your ribs, it must be applied to the ribs. Sauce must not be pooled in the container.
- 6. Marking or sculpting of any kind, of the meat or the container, will not be allowed.
- 7. Aluminum foil, toothpicks, skewers, foreign material or stuffing are not permitted. Any entry not complying with this rule will be disqualified in all judging categories.

The Rotary Clubs of Oshkosh reserve the right to amend these judging procedures at any time, as it deems necessary to benefit the contest and its contestants.
